In Africa, some heads of state sometimes prefer to take their oath on the Bible or the Quran rather than on an ancestral law or a fearsome fetish capable of causing misery in the event of a violation. Thus, in order to build credible institutions that can guarantee socio-political and economic stability, it is desirable to resort to certain ancestral practices, in particular strict respect for customs. At this level of our reflection, it seems useless for Africans to reinvent the wheel; rather, we must look in the rearview mirror in order to exalt the pre-colonial instruments capable of unravelling the invisible mystery of these societies. In this same dynamic, the ancestral law, because of its historical and charismatic legitimacy, imposes strict respect for the cosmic order. This book argues that the basic component of any society's social security and sustainability is cultural capital and its ability to fully recognise diversity in knowledge production and advancement. However, with regard to African societies, since the dawn of racial slavery and colonialism, cultural capital indigenous knowledge in particular has iniquitously and acrimoniously suffered marginalisation and pejorative ragtags. Increasingly since the 1990s, cultural capital informed by African knowledge systems has taken central stage in discussions of sustainability and development. This is not unrelated with the recognition by America and

Europe in particular of the central role that cultural capital could and should assume in the logic of development and sustainability at a global level. Unfortunately, action has often failed to match words with regard to the situation in Africa. The current book seeks to make a difference by exploring the role that African cultural capital could and should assume to guarantee development and sustainability on the continent and globally. It argues that lofty pan-African ideals of collective self-reliance, self-sustaining development and economic growth would come to naught unless determined and decisive steps are taken towards full recognition of indigenous cultural capital on the continent.

Research in African Literatures

Im Zuge der fortschreitenden Globalisierung ist die Steigerung der Leistungsfähigkeit für produzierende Unternehmen von zunehmender Relevanz. Im Laufe der Jahrzehnte haben Unternehmen diverse Maßnahmen ergriffen, um die eigene Leistungsfähigkeit zu steigern. Hierzu existieren verschiedene Methoden, welche unter dem Begriff \"Performance-Management\" zusammengefasst werden können. Durch die Anwendung dieser Methoden konnten in der Vergangenheit umfassende Leistungssteigerungen erreicht werden. Aufgrund veränderter Rahmenbedingungen sind die klassischen Methoden der Leistungssteigerung, welche vor allem unternehmensinterne Faktoren adressieren, jedoch nicht mehr zielführend. So fokussieren Unternehmen z. B. aufgrund steigender Kundenanforderungen zunehmend die eigenen Kernkompetenzen und lagern andere Wertschöpfungsaktivitäten aus. Dies führt zu einer sinkenden Fertigungstiefe der Unternehmen bei gleichzeitig steigender Komplexität der Wertschöpfungsnetzwerke. Die zunehmende unternehmensübergreifende Verflechtung erhöht die Relevanz des Supply-Chain-Managements für den Leistungserstellungsprozess produzierender Unternehmen und erfordert eine Erweiterung des Betrachtungsbereichs bei Optimierungsinitiativen. Daher wird durch die Dissertationsschrift das Ziel verfolgt, eine kennzahlenbasierte Bewertungsmetrik leistungsbestimmender Faktoren in Supply-Chains von Industriebetrieben zu entwickeln. Durch diese Bewertungsmetrik sollen Unternehmen dazu befähigt werden, Leistungssteigerungspotenziale unter Berücksichtigung von Supply-Chain-bedingten Einflussfaktoren identifizieren zu können. Hierzu werden zunächst relevante Schlüsselkennzahlen zur Beschreibung der operativen Leistungsfähigkeit ermittelt sowie Unternehmens- und Supply-Chain-Eigenschaften in Bezug auf die operative Leistungsfähigkeit charakterisiert. Darauf aufbauend erfolgen die Selektion und Analyse der leistungsbestimmenden Faktoren der Schlüsselkennzahlen. Zur Bestimmung des Supply-Chain-Einflusses auf die Leistungsfähigkeit werden die leistungsbestimmenden Faktoren hinsichtlich der Einflussart in die Kategorien Unternehmensinterner, Supply-Chain-bedingter und Exogener Einfluss eingeteilt. Anschließend werden auf Basis dieser Erkenntnisse typenspezifische Bewertungsmetriken entwickelt. Durch die Entwicklung einer Vorgehensweise wird abschließend eine anwenderspezifische Nutzung der erarbeiteten Erkenntnisse sichergestellt.
